

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

Question: What are the fees for the IB Diploma Programme?

Answer: Starting in the 2020-21 school year, there is a fee of \$3000 for the IB Diploma Programme (\$1500 in Grade 11 and \$1500 in Grade 12).

Question: When is payment due?

Answer: Below is the fee schedule for the IB Diploma Programme. Your school will provide specific instructions for how to pay the fees. For questions or additional information, please contact your school:

- Payment by February of Grade 10 upon course selection for grade 11 - \$1500
- Payment by February of Grade 11 upon course selection for grade 12 - \$1500

Question: Is there a fee for IB Prep?

Answer: There is no fee for IB Prep (Grades 9 and 10).

Question: Is there any financial assistance available for the IB Programme?

Answer: Parents/guardians who require financial support to participate in the IB Programme are encouraged to contact their school Principal.

Question: Why are there fees for the IB program and not other specialized TDSB programs?

Answer: There are costs associated with the IB Programme that are required by the International Baccalaureate Organization. These costs are related to teacher training, annual dues, program coordination, and participation in IB examinations. Other specialized programs offered at TDSB schools do not have the same required costs.
